

Quality Manager

Position Overview

The GTUIT Quality Manager will be responsible for developing and promoting the quality culture within GTUIT and to ensure ongoing compliance with the company's existing ISO 9001-15 certification. This position will be ultimately responsible for overall development, implementation, and maintenance of the organization's Quality Management System (QMS). Additionally, the Quality Manager may assist GTUIT management with other tasks as assigned such as Export Control, E-Maintenance, general production reporting, and quality related field support tasks.

Primary Job Functions:

- Traveling to GTUIT customer locations to work with field personnel and GTUIT customers
- Taking part in commissioning of new equipment at GTUIT manufacturing locations and customer sites
- Participation in the Quality Management Review of GTUIT products during manufacture
- Assembling all necessary QMS documentation needed for the shipment of any GTUIT equipment
- Assisting GTUIT management with various field related quality initiatives including E-Maintenance, software version control on deployed equipment, etc.
- Assisting GTUIT management with general reporting
- Working with engineering and executive team members in evaluating new product opportunities
- The Quality Manager will be an active participant/advocate in the promotion and advancement of GTUIT's safety culture.

Qualifications

- Minimum 5 years' experience in a quality leadership role within an engineering or manufacturing focused company with technology driven products at their core
- Minimum 3 years' experience managing ISO 9001 compliance and/or participation in the successful ISO 9001 certification of an engineering/manufacturing focused company

- BS degree desired but will consider candidates with technical degree and additional experience in quality management
- Must be very “hands-on” with a desire and aptitude for working directly with a wide variety of stakeholders including: outside vendors, field personnel, customers, regulatory agencies, GTUIT ownership, engineering & manufacturing personnel, etc.
- Must possess exceptional verbal and written communication skills. English literacy required, Spanish literacy a plus
- Demonstrated ability to foster productive working relationships across an organization
- Extremely well organized in all aspects of work. This role will consistently set the benchmark across the organization with respect to organized and efficient work flow
- Adept at using Word, Excel, as well as strong interest in learning new applications and implementing innovative IT solutions wherever possible
- Applicant must be very safety conscious with ability to work safely in highly monitored work environments
- Previous experience in the oil/energy/ natural resource sector is a plus
- Familiarity with mobile PC tools and applications
- Ability to correctly distinguish colors within mechanical/electrical assemblies and drawings
- Must have a clean driving record and be able to operate company vehicles in a safe manner
- Ability to pass pre-employment screening criteria including background check and drug test
